PHRASE AFFIRMATIVE

I	BASE FORM	I work
YOU	BASE FORM	You work
HE	BASE FORM + S	He work <mark>s</mark>
SHE	BASE FORM + S	She works
IT	BASE FORM + S	It works
WE	BASE FORM	We work
YOU	BASE FORM	You work
THEY	BASE FORM	They work



A la troisième personne du singulier, si le verbe se termine en:

- s, sh, ch, x, z, $o \rightarrow +ES$ He watches, she wishes, it does

- Consonne-Y → I + ES He cries, it flies

PHRASE NEGATIVE

DO NOT (DON'T) + BASE FORM I don't work, you don't work...

3^{ème} du singulier: **DOES NOT (DOESN'T)** + BASE FORM She doesn't work, he doesn't work, it doesn't work

PHRASE INTERROGATIVE

DO + S + BASE FORM
Do I work? Do you work?

3ème du singulier: DOES + S + BASE FORM Does she work? Does he work? Does it work?
